

Word Field Codes

Why would you use them? -> Dynamic Content





Word Field Codes

What is a Field Code?

Microsoft defines a Field Code as placeholder for data that might change in a document giving you precise control over dynamic text in your document.

Important field codes

- If-Condition
 {if"<<CRM_FIELD>>"="CompareValue" "Content if condition is fulfilled" "Content if condition is not fulfilled"}
- Format strings:
 \@,,dddd, MMM d, yyyy"
 =,Thursday, June 1, 2017"
- *Cardtext
 3 -> Three
- *Ordinal 1 -> 1st

Examples:

- Salutation (Dear Mrs. vs Dear Mr.)
- Shipping Information based on Shipping Method or Freight Terms
- Terms and Conditions based on Country/State

e.g. If customer State returns "Georgia":

- Add contact details from GA
- Insert state specific content
 - Insert a picture
 - Insert Table
